

Cub Camp Final Joining Instructions

We will be travelling to Camp by train this year from Bagshot Station. We will be catching the 1553 train to Ascot, so could you please ensure that your child is dropped off at the station no later than 1530 please. Cubs must travel in Uniform and have shoes appropriate for a 3 mile walk off road.

The Cubs will be carrying some basic gear which is highlighted in the kit list below. All other gear – sleeping and clothes mainly- needs to be delivered to the campsite in Ascot. Hopefully we can consolidate this into a few cars at the station drop off to save on individual journeys to site. Eating utensils and plates are not needed this time. It will be cold at night, so if your sleeping bag is a summer only one, please ensure a warm blanket is packed too.

If your child is not camping on Friday night please drop them off at the site and let a leader know they are there. They will need just one change of clothes and footwear as well as the 'to be carried' equipment, penknife and tea towel.
